- More choice in selection of Delivery Method (instead of using Comments field)

#### **Routing by Library Group**

- An entire Library Group will populate one line within a cell
- System will randomly select from 20 libraries within that group in order to provide increase pool of lenders

#### **Rush**

- "RUSH Request #####" will appear next to Receipt number
- Log onto DOCLINE: Rush requests will show in a different color
